



**PRAY THE WORLD MISSION ROSARY & EMBRACE THE WORLD IN PRAYER!**

During the *Year of Faith*, join the international prayer campaign for evangelization by praying the *World Mission Rosary*. Pope Benedict XVI asked all of the faithful to join in praying the World Mission Rosary during the Year of Faith in order to “accompany the work of evangelizing the world and for many of the baptized to rediscover and deepen the faith.” [Address to the National Directors of the Pontifical Mission Societies 5/11/12]

**Organize a Living World Mission Rosary**

Incorporate the colors of the *World Mission Rosary* using ribbons, tee shirts, paper beads, candles or balloons.

Prepare by assigning groups of students to learn about each area of the world and share their new knowledge.



Use the *World Mission Rosary* Power point available on the MCA website.

If possible, pray the *Hail Mary* in languages in addition to English.

Include images of the Blessed Mother from other countries [e.g., *Our Lady of Seshan*, *Our Lady of Kibeho*].

Invite families, including grandparents, to join the children in prayer.

**Pray the Rosary during Adoration**

Pray the *WMR* as part of a Eucharistic Holy Hour for the Missions. Find the program guide at [www.phillymissions.org](http://www.phillymissions.org). Adoration intention cards are available through MCA.

Make *World Mission Rosaries* available during Eucharistic Adoration.

**Create A Bulletin Board**

Create [or help your students create] reusable cards with the *World Mission Rosary* Mission intentions.

Assist your MCA members in creating a World Mission Rosary bulletin board. Contact MCA for photos from the Missions.

Keep a tally of rosaries prayed by the children on the bulletin board or wall display.

Children can learn how to pray the Rosary in the *World Mission Rosary* brochure.

**Make a World Mission Rosary Chaplet**

Provide children or families with supplies to make a five- or ten-bead chaplet in the colors of the *World Mission Rosary*.

**Make Rosaries for the Missions**

Recruit some additional adult volunteers and teach the children how to make *World Mission Rosaries*. Some Missionary Childhood groups within the Archdiocese of Philadelphia donate rosaries to the Missions through our office each year. These rosaries are now in the hands of children in Malawi, Sri Lanka, Peru, Bangladesh, and the Dominican Republic.

**Tell the Stories of Mission Saints**
