I'm sorry for all the times I belittled or hurt you in the person of your brothers and sisters, in my attitudes of pride, envy, anger, impatience and indifference. Teach me to accept humiliations and grow in kindness and generous love, so that I may grow in your likeness.

Jesus carries his cross

Lord Jesus, you accepted the burden of the cross on your way to being executed. Give me the grace, the courage and the sincere desire to take up my cross daily and follow you more closely.

Jesus dies on the Cross

Lord Jesus, you loved us and gave your life for us on the Cross.
